**Scholarships for Undergraduate Students for the Second Semester
of Academic Year 2025**

Type: Student Assistants for Lecturers/Faculty Office

The Faculty of Political Science and Public Administration has allocated a portion of its income budget to provide scholarships for student assistants who will support lecturers and/or the Faculty Office during the **second semester of the academic year 2025**, with a remuneration rate of **50 Baht per hour**.

In order to ensure that the recruitment process meets its objectives, the Faculty hereby sets forth the following criteria and conditions:

1. Qualifications of Applicants

- 1.1 Applicants must be undergraduate students of the Faculty of Political Science and Public Administration, currently enrolled in **Years 1 – 4**, and registered for courses in the **second semester of the academic year 2025**.
- 1.2 Applicants must demonstrate **good conduct** and **must not have been subject to any disciplinary actions** during the previous or current academic year.
- 1.3 Applicants must have **sufficient availability** to assist lecturers or the Faculty Office as assigned.
- 1.4 Applicants should possess **computer skills**, including proficiency in **Microsoft Office** and/or other programs such as **graphic design software, video editing programs, Canva, Google Sheets, or dashboard creation tools**, etc.

2. Conditions

Recipients of the scholarship must perform assigned duties as **assistants to lecturers and/or the Faculty Office**, supporting the academic and administrative responsibilities as deemed appropriate. The work period shall be from **17 November 2025 to 13 March 2026**.

3. Application Period

Applications are open **from now until 31 October 2025**, via the **online system**.
