# Scholarships for Undergraduate Students for the Second Semester of Academic Year 2025 Type: Student Assistants for Lecturers/Faculty Office

# 1. Qualifications of Applicants

- 1.1 Applicants must be undergraduate students of the Faculty of Political Science and Public Administration, currently enrolled in Years 1 4, and registered for courses in the second semester of the academic year 2025.
- 1.2 Applicants must demonstrate good conduct and must not have been subject to any disciplinary actions during the previous or current academic year.
- 1.3 Applicants must have **sufficient availability** to assist lecturers or the Faculty Office as assigned.
- 1.4 Applicants should possess computer skills, including proficiency in Microsoft Office and/or other programs such as graphic design software, video editing programs, Canva, Google Sheets, or dashboard creation tools, etc.

#### 2. Conditions

Recipients of the scholarship must perform assigned duties as assistants to lecturers and/or the Faculty Office, supporting the academic and administrative responsibilities as deemed appropriate. The work period shall be from 17 November 2025 to 13 March 2026.

Applications are open from now until 31 October 2025, via the online system.
