Nomination & Application

MCUT only accepts applications with official nominations from the partner universities. The required documents for application should be sent to Ms. Fanny (fannygao@mail.mcut.edu.tw) via the international office of home university by the designated deadlines.

Applicants of our exchange programs should provide the following items/documents **composed in English**:

- [MCUT Application form](#) (typed, not handwritten)
 - ID photo
 - Autobiography and Curriculum Vitae
 - [Study Plan](#)
 - International English Test Score (TOEIC, IELTS, TOEFL, etc.) minimum CEFR B1 level or above
 - Photo page of passport & Student ID
 - Official Certificate of Enrollment from home university
 - Official Transcripts of Records (all courses taken so far)
 - At least two Recommendation Letters from professors at the home university
 - Financial Statement (Minimum USD 3,000)
- ✓ All documents (Items 1–10) **must be compiled into a single PDF file** and arranged in the exact order listed above.
- ✓ **Direct submissions from students are not accepted.** All materials must be submitted by the **coordinator** of the home university to MCUT via mail.
- ✓ **Missing documents may affect the nomination result;** please ensure all required materials are submitted in full by the deadline.

Deadlines for receiving exchange student applications:

- **Fall semester intake: 1st January - 30th April**
- **Spring semester intake: 1st August - 15th October**

Any delayed applications will not be processed.
