



Announcement of the Faculty of Political Science and Public Administration
Re: Scholarship Award Results for Participation in Student Exchange Programs at Overseas
Universities Fiscal Year 2026

With reference to the Announcement of the Faculty of Political Science and Public Administration, Chiang Mai University, regarding Scholarships for Participation in Student Exchange Programs at Overseas Universities for Fiscal Year 2026, dated 20 October 2025, the Faculty's Internationalization Management Committee has completed the selection process.

The Committee has selected four (4) students to receive scholarships under the Short-term Student Exchange Program (less than one academic semester). Each recipient will be awarded financial support of up to THB 15,000 to cover eligible expenses incurred during participation in the exchange program, including round-trip airfare, accommodation, travel insurance and visa fees. The scholarship will be reimbursed based on actual expenses incurred, not exceeding the approved amount. The selected students are as follows:

Recipients are required to confirm their acceptance of the scholarship by submitting the required documents: original receipt form, a copy of the recipient's national identification card or passport, a copy of the recipient's Siam Commercial Bank (SCB) savings account showing the recipient as the account holder, and original receipts for the eligible expenses listed above. The required documents must be submitted to the International Relations Unit, Research and Academic Services Office, between 6–20 July 2026 (no later than 4:00 p.m.). Each copy of the supporting documents must be signed to certify its authenticity. Failure to submit the required documents within the specified period shall be deemed a waiver of the scholarship.
