

**Announcement of the Faculty of Political Science and Public Administration
Chiang Mai University**

Scholarships for Undergraduate Students for the Academic Year 2026

Type: Educational Support Scholarship

The Faculty of Political Science and Public Administration has allocated funds from its income budget and has also received scholarship donations from foundations, associations, and individuals. These funds are intended to be distributed as scholarships for students within the faculty who are in need of financial assistance to support their education.

Accordingly, the faculty is now accepting applications from undergraduate students who wish to apply for the **Educational Support Scholarship** for the academic year 2026, under the following criteria:

1. Eligibility Requirements

- 1.1 Must be an undergraduate student of the Faculty of Political Science and Public Administration, from the first year onwards (student ID starting with 69... and earlier), and enrolled in the Academic Year 2026.
- 1.2 Must demonstrate financial need and require educational support.
- 1.3 Must have good conduct and must not have been subject to any disciplinary action in the previous or current academic year.

Note: First-year students refer to those (student ID starting with 69...) who will begin their undergraduate studies in the Faculty of Political Science and Public Administration in Academic Year 2026.

2. Required Supporting Documents

- 2.1 A completed scholarship application form (12 pages)
- 2.2 The following items must be uploaded within the application form:
 - 2.2.1 A photograph of the student in university uniform (1 photo)
 - 2.2.2 Three photos of the student's permanent residence:
 - Photo 1: Close-up of the house showing the house number
 - Photo 2: Close-up showing the entire house
 - Photo 3: Wide shot of the front of the house including surrounding areas, carport, sky, and ground

Note: All photos must be signed and certified at the bottom-right corner (front side) by the village headman, subdistrict chief, or a

government officer of at least level 5 or equivalent, to confirm that the residence belongs to the student.

2.2.3 A hand-drawn **map showing the route** from the student's house to the main road or national highway, clearly indicating directions and kilometer markers.

2.3 An official **family income certification**, with a copy of the government officer's ID card. For executives from private institutions, a copy of their national ID card with "certified true copy" must be attached.

3. Application Procedures

3.1 Complete the application form and screening form for Academic Year 2026 via the website <http://sis.cmu.ac.th>. using your CMU Account, **from now until 9 June 2026 (23:59 hrs)**.

Note: First-year students (student ID 69...) are required to log in using their national identification number.

3.2 Print the application and screening forms along with supporting documents (1 set), including:

3.2.1 Signed income certification document (page 8), with a certified copy of a government official ID card or equivalent document, or in the case of a private institution executive, a certified copy of a national ID card.

3.2.2 Signed advisor's recommendation letter (page 9).

Note: First-year students must submit a recommendation letter signed by their school teacher.

3.3 Submit the application by one of the following methods:

1) Submit in person at the Educational Services and Student Quality Development Unit, Faculty of Political Science and Public Administration, by 9 June 2026, during official working hours only; or

The postmark/shipping date must be no later than 9 June 2026.

3.4 Applications submitted and confirmed in the system within the specified deadline will be reviewed and screened by the Faculty.
