**Announcement of the Faculty of Political Science and Public Administration
Re: Scholarships for Participation in Student Exchange Programs at
Overseas Universities for the Fiscal Year 2026**

In accordance with the mission of the Faculty of Political Science and Public Administration, Chiang Mai University, to promote the development of change agents for good governance in a sustainable society, the faculty supports students in participating in exchange programs at overseas universities, providing opportunities for academic learning and valuable international experiences.

In this regard, the Faculty of Political Science and Public Administration is now accepting applications from students seeking scholarships to participate in student exchange programs at overseas universities for the Fiscal Year 2026, under the following criteria.

1. Qualifications of Scholarship Applicants

1.1 Applicants must be undergraduate students (2nd – 4th year) of the Faculty of Political Science and Public Administration.

1.2 Applicants must demonstrate good conduct and must not have any record of disciplinary action.

1.3 Applicants must have been officially selected to participate in a student exchange program at an overseas university.

1.4 Applicants must not be receiving full financial support for the exchange program from the host organization or may be recipients of partial financial support only.

2. Scholarship Criteria

2.1 For participation in exchange programs lasting one semester or longer, students may receive financial support up to 50,000 Baht (fifty thousand baht only). For exchange programs lasting less than one semester, students may receive support up to 15,000 Baht (fifteen thousand baht only). The scholarship may be used to cover round-trip airfare, accommodation, travel insurance, and visa fees. Reimbursement will be based on actual expenses incurred.

2.2 In cases where actual expenses arise beyond those specified in Clause 2.1, reimbursement approval shall be subject to the discretion of the Faculty Executive Committee on a case-by-case basis.

2.3 If a scholarship recipient is unable to complete the exchange program for the duration specified in the program, the student shall be required to fully return the scholarship to the faculty.

2.4 Students receiving the scholarship must present the outcomes and experiences gained from the exchange program in at least one knowledge-sharing activity organized by the faculty after completion of the program.

3. Selection Criteria

3.1 Applicants must possess all qualifications specified in Section 1.

3.2 The exchange program must be conducted with a university or organization having academic cooperation agreements with the faculty or Chiang Mai University; or a university ranked in the QS World University Rankings; or a university recognized by the Office of the Civil Service Commission (OCSC), Thailand.

3.3 The Committee for International Mission Administration and Management of the Faculty of Political Science and Public Administration shall consider and select qualified applicants.

3.4 The Dean of the Faculty of Political Science and Public Administration shall make the final decision, which shall be deemed final.

4. Required Application Documents

4.1 Completed scholarship application form for participation in student exchange programs at overseas universities, Fiscal Year 2026

4.2 One photograph in student uniform or formal attire

4.3 A copy of a passport valid throughout the exchange program period

4.4 Academic transcript

4.5 Official acceptance letter for participation in the student exchange program at an overseas university

4.6 English proficiency test results or other relevant foreign language test results (if any)

5. Application Period

Applications will be accepted from 1 October 2025 to 31 July 2026 during official office hours at the International Relations Unit, Research Administration and Academic Services Division, the Faculty of Political Science and Public Administration.

6. Announcement of Selected Students

The list of selected students will be announced after approval by the Committee for International Mission Administration and Management of the Faculty of Political Science and Public Administration. The announcement will be published on the faculty website: www.pol.cmu.ac.th
