Faculty of Political Science and Public Administration, Chiang Mai University
Subject: Scholarships for Undergraduate Students in the International Program
First Semester, Academic Year 2026

The Faculty of Political Science and Public Administration, Chiang Mai University, has allocated funds from its revenue-funded expenditure budget and has received scholarship support from PTT Exploration and Production Public Company Limited (PTTEP). The scholarships are intended to expand educational opportunities for students with strong academic performance and/or financial need; to develop students' academic capabilities and practical skills; and to contribute to the development of high-quality human resources for the country's sustainable development. They are also intended to encourage and motivate students to pursue their studies diligently, achieve the academic standards prescribed by the faculty, and complete their education. The faculty therefore establishes the following scholarship categories and selection criteria:

1. PTTEP Educational Support Scholarship: awarded to undergraduate students enrolled in the international program, Faculty of Political Science and Public Administration. Each scholarship provides 50,000 baht per semester, for a total scholarship amount of 400,000 baht throughout the program. A total of five (5) scholarships are available.
2. PTTEP Tuition Fee Support Scholarship: awarded to undergraduate students enrolled in the international program, Faculty of Political Science and Public Administration. Each scholarship is valued at 50,000 baht. A total of fifteen (15) scholarships are available.
3. Academic Excellence Scholarship: awarded to undergraduate students enrolled in the international program, Faculty of Political Science and Public Administration. Each scholarship is valued at 25,000 baht.
4. Academic Excellence and Financial Need Scholarship: awarded to undergraduate students enrolled in the international program, Faculty of Political Science and Public Administration. Each scholarship is valued at 50,000 baht.

1. Qualifications for Scholarship Applicants

- 1.1 PTT Exploration and Production Public Company Limited (PTTEP) Educational Support Scholarship: 50,000 baht per semester, totaling 400,000 baht throughout the program
 - 1.1.1 Applicants must be Thai nationals enrolled as undergraduate students in the international program, Faculty of Political Science and Public Administration, whose student ID numbers begin with 691915xxx. They must be registered in the first semester of the 2026 academic year.
 - 1.1.2 Applicants must have a cumulative grade point average (GPAX) of at least 3.50 at the upper secondary school level.
 - 1.1.3 Recipients must maintain a cumulative grade point average (GPAX) of at least 3.50 at the end of every semester throughout the scholarship period to remain eligible for continued scholarship support until graduation.
 - 1.1.4 Applicants must demonstrate financial need.

- 1.1.5 Applicants must demonstrate good conduct and must never have been subject to student disciplinary action.
- 1.2 PTT Exploration and Production Public Company Limited (PTTEP) Tuition Fee Support Scholarship: 50,000 baht per scholarship
 - 1.2.1 Applicants must be Thai nationals enrolled as undergraduate students in the international program, Faculty of Political Science and Public Administration, whose student ID numbers begin with 681915xxx or 691915xxx. They must be registered in the first semester of the 2026 academic year.
 - 1.2.2 Applicants whose student ID numbers begin with 691915xxx must have a cumulative grade point average (GPAX) of at least 3.50 at the upper secondary school level.
 - 1.2.3 Applicants whose student ID numbers begin with 681915xxx must have a cumulative grade point average (GPAX) of at least 3.50.
 - 1.2.4 Applicants must demonstrate good conduct and must never have been subject to student disciplinary action.
- 1.3 Academic Excellence Scholarship, Faculty of Political Science and Public Administration: 25,000 baht per scholarship
 - 1.3.1 Applicants must be undergraduate students enrolled in the international program, Faculty of Political Science and Public Administration, whose student ID numbers begin with 681915xxx or 691915xxx. They must be registered in the first semester of the 2026 academic year.
 - 1.3.2 Applicants whose student ID numbers begin with 691915xxx must have a cumulative grade point average (GPAX) of at least 3.25 at the upper secondary school level.
 - 1.3.3 Applicants whose student ID numbers begin with 681915xxx must have a cumulative grade point average (GPAX) of at least 3.25 and must never have received an F or U grade.
 - 1.3.4 Applicants must demonstrate good conduct and must never have been subject to student disciplinary action.
- 1.4 Academic Excellence and Financial Need Scholarship, Faculty of Political Science and Public Administration: 50,000 baht per scholarship
 - 1.4.1 Applicants must be undergraduate students enrolled in the international program, Faculty of Political Science and Public Administration, whose student ID numbers begin with 681915xxx or 691915xxx. They must be registered in the first semester of the 2026 academic year.
 - 1.4.2 Applicants whose student ID numbers begin with 691915xxx must have a cumulative grade point average (GPAX) of at least 3.50 at the upper secondary school level.
 - 1.4.3 Applicants whose student ID numbers begin with 681915xxx must have a cumulative grade point average (GPAX) of at least 3.50 and must never have received an F or U grade.
 - 1.4.4 Applicants must demonstrate financial need.
 - 1.4.5 Applicants must demonstrate good conduct and must never have been subject to student disciplinary action.

2. Required Application Documents

- 2.1 One set of a completed scholarship application form.
- 2.2 An English essay entitled “Student’s Learning Goals,” one A4 page in length, using Times New Roman, 16-point font.
- 2.3 For applicants whose student ID numbers begin with 691915xxx: an upper secondary school transcript showing the cumulative grade point average (GPAX).
- 2.4 For applicants whose student ID numbers begin with 681915xxx: an academic transcript showing the cumulative grade point average (GPAX). for the 2025 academic year.

3. Application Procedure

- 3.1 Submit one (1) complete set of the documents listed in Section 2 in person to the Academic Services and Student Affairs Section, Faculty of Political Science and Public Administration, by **July 24, 2026, during official working days and hours only.**
- 3.2 Scan all documents listed in Section 2 and send them by email to **esg-pol@cmu.ac.th by 4:30 p.m. on July 24, 2026.**

4. Announcement of Applicants Eligible for Interview

The list of applicants eligible for interviews will be announced on the faculty’s website at www.pol.cmu.ac.th by **July 31, 2026.**

5. Interview Schedule

Interviews will be held on **August 5, 2026.** Interview times and further details will be announced on the faculty’s website at www.pol.cmu.ac.th

6. Announcement of Scholarship Recipients

The scholarship selection results will be announced by **the end of August 2026** on the Faculty’s website at www.pol.cmu.ac.th.

7. Scholarship Terms and Conditions

Students may apply for all scholarship categories announced herein if they meet the eligibility criteria for each category. However, each student is eligible to receive only one scholarship under this announcement.
